**Re: Alleged Violation of NRS 281.571(1) (d); Wheeler
File #C13-17 SOS**

Dear Assemblyman Wheeler:

We last spoke regarding this matter on October 8, 2013. At that time you indicated you would follow-up with this office regarding the allegation that you failed to properly disclose Michigan state tax liens on your previously filed statements of financial disclosure (FDS). I have yet to receive any follow-up on this issue. On October 24, this office received a supplement to the complaint from the complainant. A copy of the supplement is attached for your review.

At issue are multiple allegations of misreporting on your previously filed FDS. Including the initial complaint, the following allegations (and supporting documentation) have been brought to our attention and are still outstanding:

- Failure to disclose the Michigan state tax liens your 2010 Candidate FDS, 2012 Candidate FDS and 2013 Annual FDS (from the original complaint).
- Failure to appropriately identify the Section B sources of income in your 2010 Candidate FDS, 2012 Candidate FDS and 2013 Annual FDS. You have only listed "employment" or "insurance." You must identify by name the businesses or sources of income for you and any applicable household members during the applicable time periods.
- Failure to properly identify Section F business entities in your 2010 Candidate FDS. Please refer to the enclosed supplement, page 2, paragraphs 2 – 6, for the specifics of the misreporting allegations.
- Inconsistencies in your 2010 Candidate FDS, 2012 Candidate FDS and 2013 Annual FDS related to: (i) length of residence in Nevada; and (ii) length of residence in the district where you are registered to vote.

RE: Assemblyman Jim Wheeler, AD 39, Supplemental Complaint

Dear Secretary Miller:

On September 30, 2013, I filed a complaint with your office regarding Assemblyman Jim Wheeler, AD 39. Since the time of filing the complaint, I have uncovered additional information regarding Mr. Wheeler that is relevant to your Office's consideration of this matter. I have notified the relevant State authorities regarding some of this information. It is my opinion, however, that this information substantiates additional violations of Nevada law related to Statements of Financial Disclosure. I also respectfully submit that this information is evidence of Mr. Wheeler's willful and unlawful failure to comply with the law. As such, I offer the following supplemental information to my original complaint.

As the Nevada Commission on Ethics states, the reason for strict laws requiring disclosure and transparency from Nevada's elected officials, is "to enhance the public's faith and confidence in government by ensuring that public officers...[and] uphold the public trust."

Attached again are copies of Financial Disclosure Forms filed by Floyd James Wheeler III in 2010, Jim Wheeler in 2012 and Assemblyman Jim Wheeler in 2013. They are the same person. (Exhibits #1, #2, #3) These documents have been filed with the your Office and *sworn to their accuracy and complete truthfulness under penalty of perjury.*

In **SECTION B** (Sources of Income) in Floyd James Wheeler III's 2010 Financial Disclosure Statement (exhibit #1), Wheeler lists himself as being "self-employed," but doesn't list the name or nature of his business. In Wheeler's 2012 (exhibit #2) Financial Disclosure Statement, he lists both "insurance and employment" in the sources of income section (B), but once again fails to disclose in any detail his actual sources of income, or to whom he may be beholden. The same lack of information is given in his 2013 Financial Disclosure Statement.

Legislators, as well other elected officials and various officials are required to fill out this form in order for the public to know and recognize the sources of income so that conflicts in voting can be identified. In fact, all such officials are required to disclose such conflicts prior to voting or abstaining.

Even lawmakers who are retired list, if applicable, Social Security, PERS, etc. as sources of income. Mr. Wheeler defies the principle and purpose of the Disclosure Form by not disclosing the source of his employment. The intentional concealment of this information undermines the very purpose for which these Statements are required. It is, in a practical sense, the equivalent to not filing the Statement at all.

Additionally, where Mr. Wheeler is required to list any affiliation with business entities in his 2010 Disclosure Statement, (Exhibit #1), (SECTION F Business Entities) he merely writes "nothing applicable" meaning no connection to any company or business entity operated for economic gain. But in his 2012 and 2013 Disclosure Statements (Exhibits #2 and #3), Mr. Wheeler lists under the same section (SECTION F Business Entities) two companies: **WheelerCo Products, Inc.** and **Barotex Corp.**

On the surface, a reasonable person might say that Assemblyman Wheeler became involved with both businesses between 2010 (when he first reported N/A to Section F) and 2012 and 2013 when he subsequently reported having a fiduciary interest in both. Obviously, one does not have to live in a state to do business there.

The problem here for Mr. Wheeler, and the public, is that Assemblyman Wheeler's involvement with **WheelerCo Products, Inc.**, dates back to a company bearing his name, in which Los Angeles Superior Court records, (Exhibit #4) Case # MC017282, show two judgments totaling \$99,585.00 in 2006, rendered in favor of the plaintiff, California Bank and Trust against "defendant" **WheelerCo Inc.**

While there is no crime in having a business fail in the United States, as Wheeler's did, why was it not listed in 2010 (in his first disclosure report, closer to the time of his actual involvement with the company) as either a source of income or a debt, and was listed in 2012 and 2013 under SECTION F (Business Entities) as an alleged source of income?

The second business "entity" listed by Mr. Wheeler in his 2012 and 2013 disclosure forms, was **Barotex Corp.** According to the Nevada Secretary of State's website, Barotex's status as a business entity has been "revoked." Search of the company's website (www.barotex.com) reveals the statement: "Note that the company [Barotex] is currently in startup mode with no revenues at this time." A call to the company's listed phone number (818) 672-1256 receives an error message saying: "The phone number you have called is disconnected or no longer in service."

In examining all three Financial Disclosure Statements, there are numerous conflicts in the answers. In January of 2010, Mr. Wheeler claims to have lived in Nevada four years. In March of 2012, he claims to have lived in Nevada nine

years and by January of 2013, he states he's lived here 10 years.

Besides pointing out the discrepancies on his two previous Financial Disclosure Statements indicating different lengths of supposed residency in Nevada, there is actually a question as to whether or not Assemblyman Wheeler actually lives in District 39. While I recognize that this information may relate to a violation of Nevada law that is not within your Office's oversight (as Mr. Wheeler is currently in elected office, and not a candidate), I would nonetheless submit that this information shows a pattern of deception by Mr. Wheeler, and the absence of any credible evidence that Mr. Wheeler lives in AD 39 is wholly consistent with his intentional concealment of income and debts in his Statement of Financial Disclosure.

The reason why Mr. Wheeler's residency at 965 Tillman Lane has been questioned is that the home is owned and occupied by a political supporter of Mr. Wheeler's, by the name of Jim DeGraffenreid, (Exhibit #5) who is Chairman of the Nevada Republican Party's Special Committee on Legislation, and has recently been elected Vice Chairman of the Nevada Republican Party.

The questions arises, why would Mr. Wheeler have his residence at the 1700 sq. ft., three bedroom of another family and political supporter for the past five years? Why would he not have purchased, or at least rented his "own residence" in the district, having been a "resident" of Nevada for the past seven to ten years, depending upon which Financial Disclosure Statement is to be believed.

To that end, [REDACTED] (exhibit #6) undertook a surveillance of Mr. Wheeler to confirm whether or not he was residing at **2110 White Pine Drive in Washoe Valley, NV**. The residence, rented by Mr. Wheeler's acknowledged female companion, Eileen Thompson, is where Wheeler has been observed frequently coming and going. The enclosed [REDACTED] report finds Wheeler's 2004 White Explorer bearing Nevada License plate "**State Assembly 43**" parked at Thompson's residence regularly during the three day period of observation.

If these observations are mere coincidences, from a simple visit or "stay" with a friend, this should be easily cleared up by Mr. Wheeler showing proof (rental receipts, utility bills, phone bills, etc.) from "staying" at supporter DeGraffenreid's home for at least the past five years. Of even greater interest is if he's paying for the rent, what is the source of him income. If someone is supplying him with money for his residence or granting it to him free of charge, does that not constitute a gift?

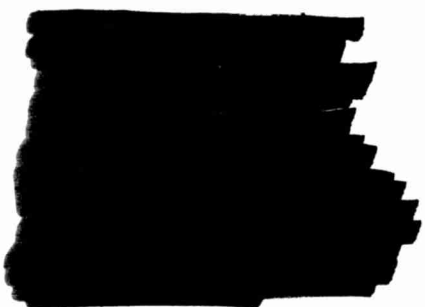
Assemblyman Wheeler states on his campaign website (www.wheeler4nevada.org--exhibit #7) under "About Jim," that "he was finally able to realize his dream in 2003 when he bought a small ranch in Gardnerville." And while it is true that Jim, and his wife at that time, Debra, did purchase a property located at 135 Fredricksburg Road in Gardnerville, he sold the property

one year later, and never lived there as evidenced by the aerial maps (exhibit #8) taken during the period in question, showing there was no residence situated on it. Documents filed relating to the Fredricksburg Road property, were forwarded by request, to a California residence of the Wheelers at the time--more evidence that Wheeler was "not" a Nevada resident at the time he claimed in his Financial Disclosure Statements.

Financial integrity is not a prerequisite for being elected to public office. Ethical and honest integrity is. Mr. Wheeler's conflicts in his length of time in Nevada, his name(s), lack of any source(s) of income, a tax lien, personal debts, and inaccurate facts about his residency—in *three* Statements of Financial Disclosure offer enough evidence to require an investigation.

The Nevada Legislature has required that your office find that Mr. Wheeler has "willfully" failed to report before you can find a violation in this matter. I respectfully submit that given the sum of the information above, it is reasonable, if not inevitable, to conclude that Mr. Wheeler intentionally failed to disclose the information required by law because the information reflects poorly on his fitness to hold office.

I ask that my allegations and charges be investigated and a determination made for the benefit of the citizens of AD 39 and the people of the State of Nevada. As always, if you desire any additional information from me, please let me know and I will be happy to oblige.

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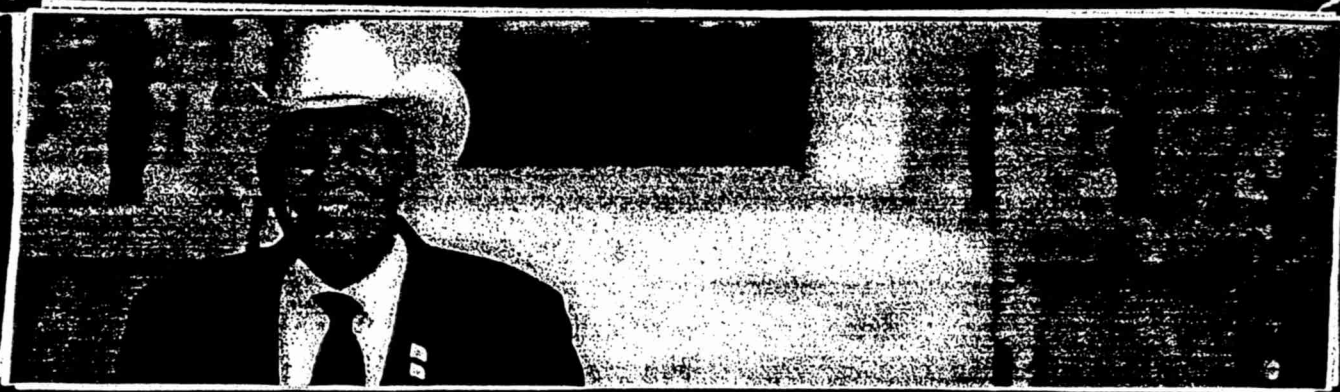
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ABOUT JIM

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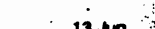
