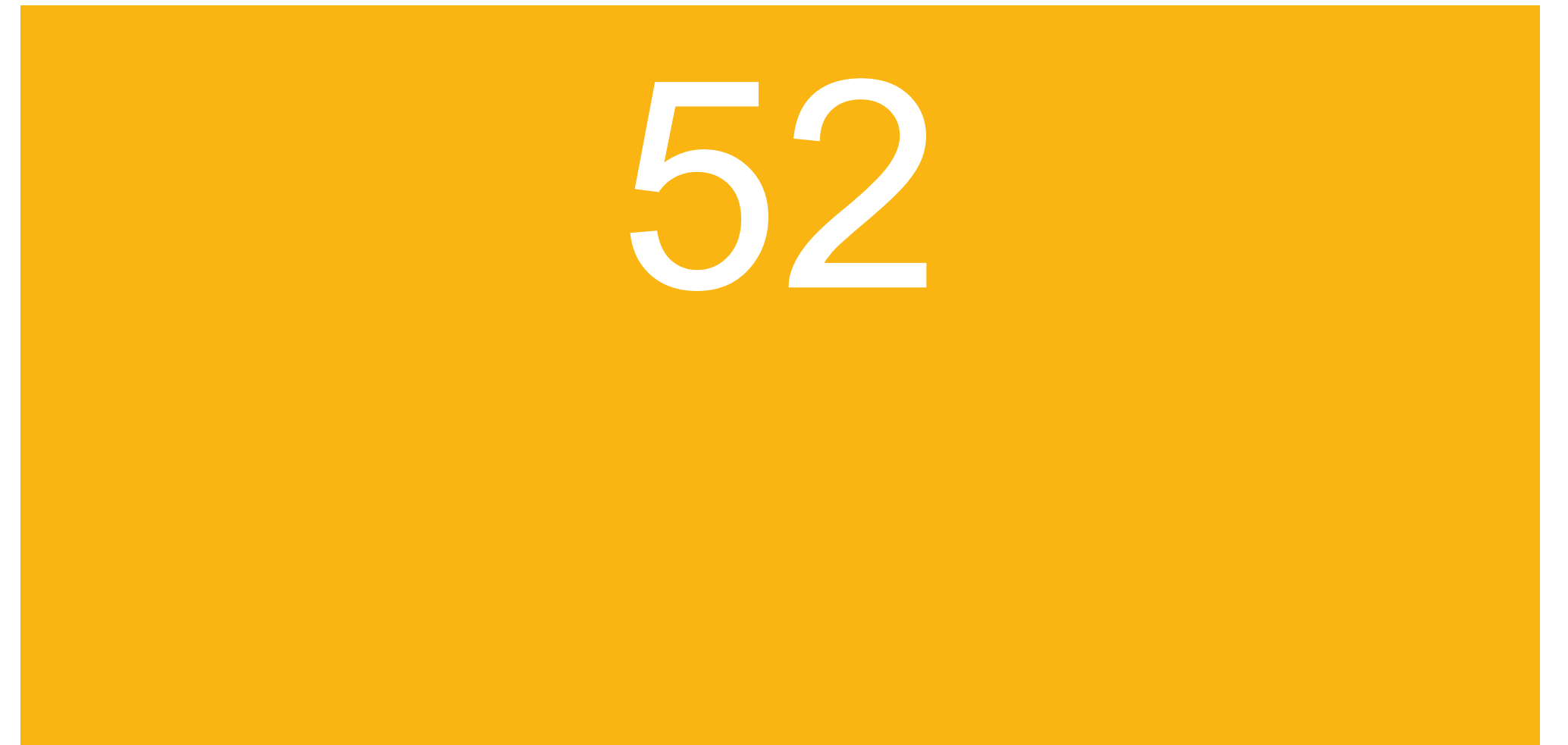
Would you say things in the country are headed in the right direction, or are things seriously headed off on the wrong track?

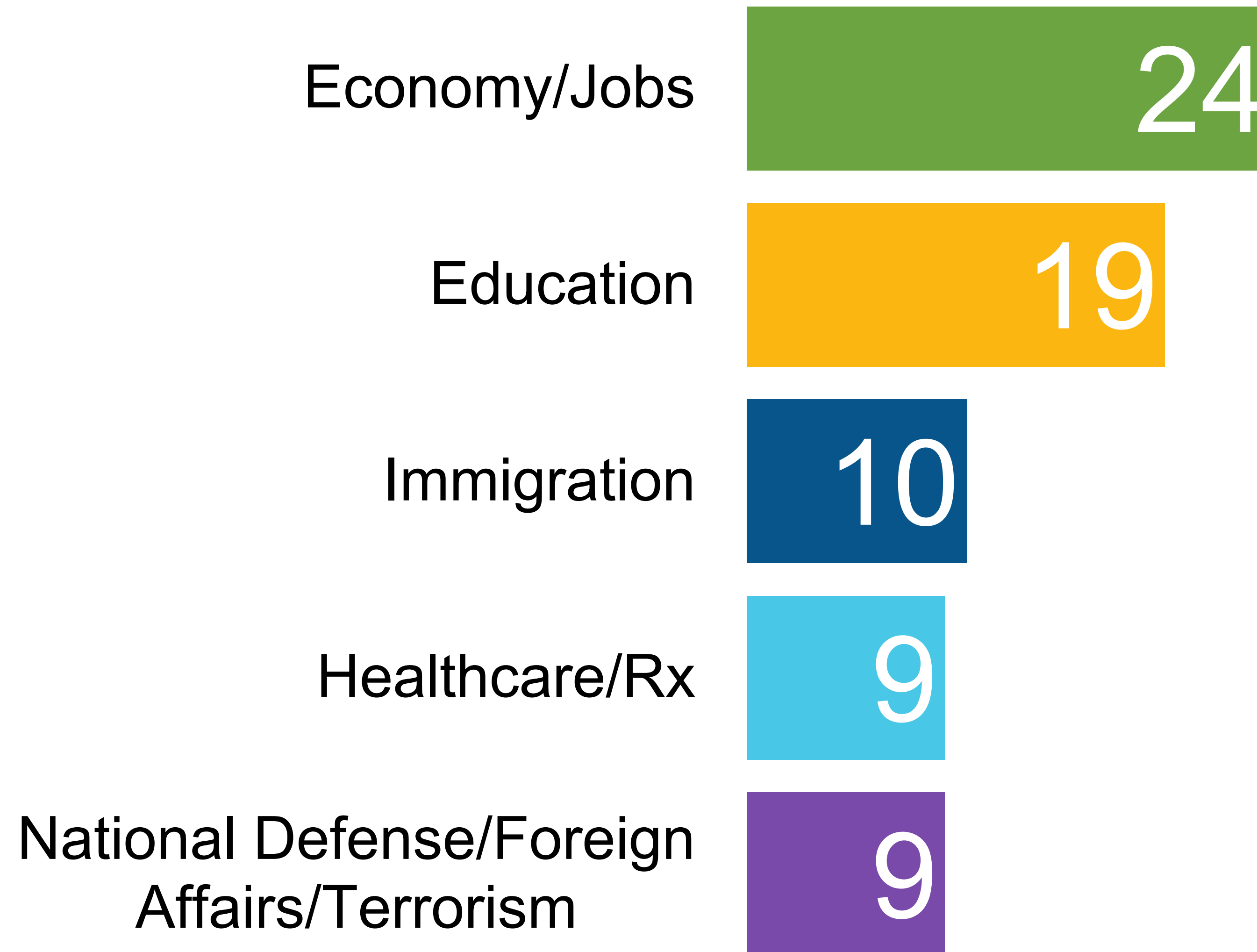
Right Direction

Wrong Track

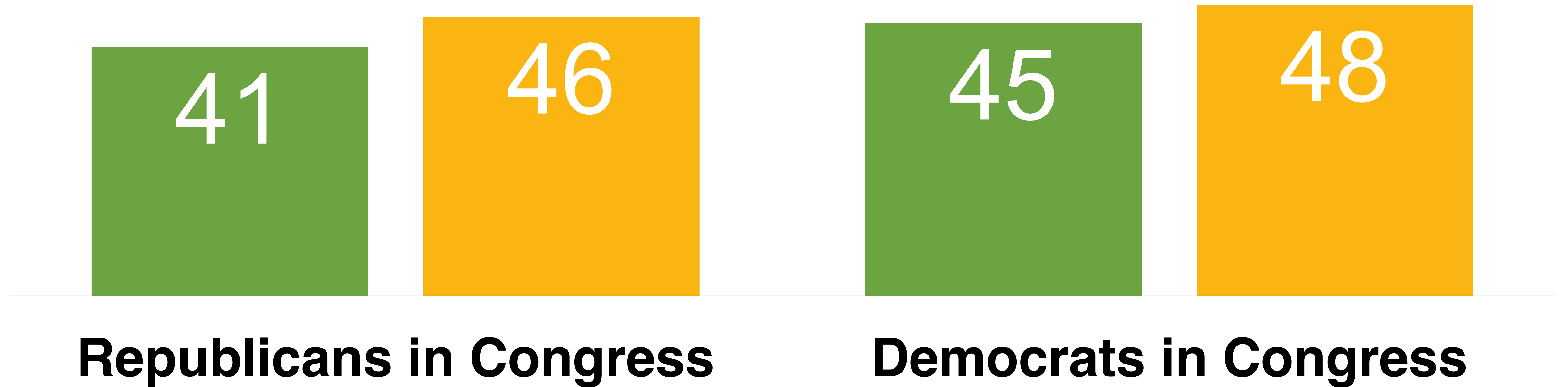


In thinking about the recent election, which of the following would you say was most important to you in deciding how to vote for Congress?

(Top 5)



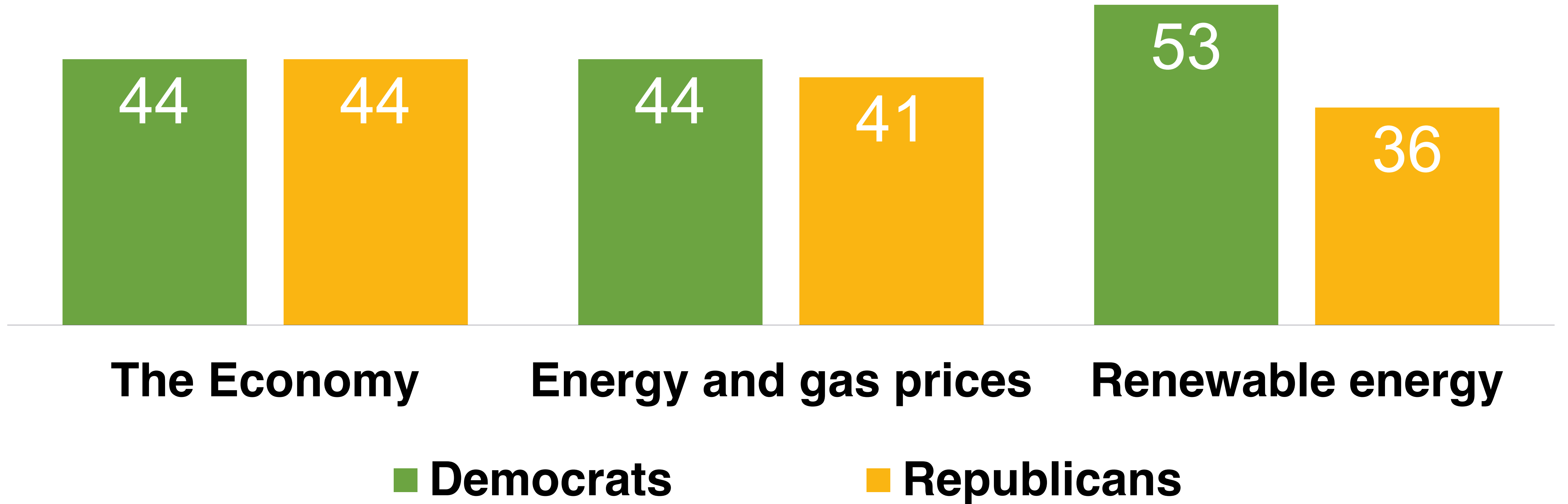

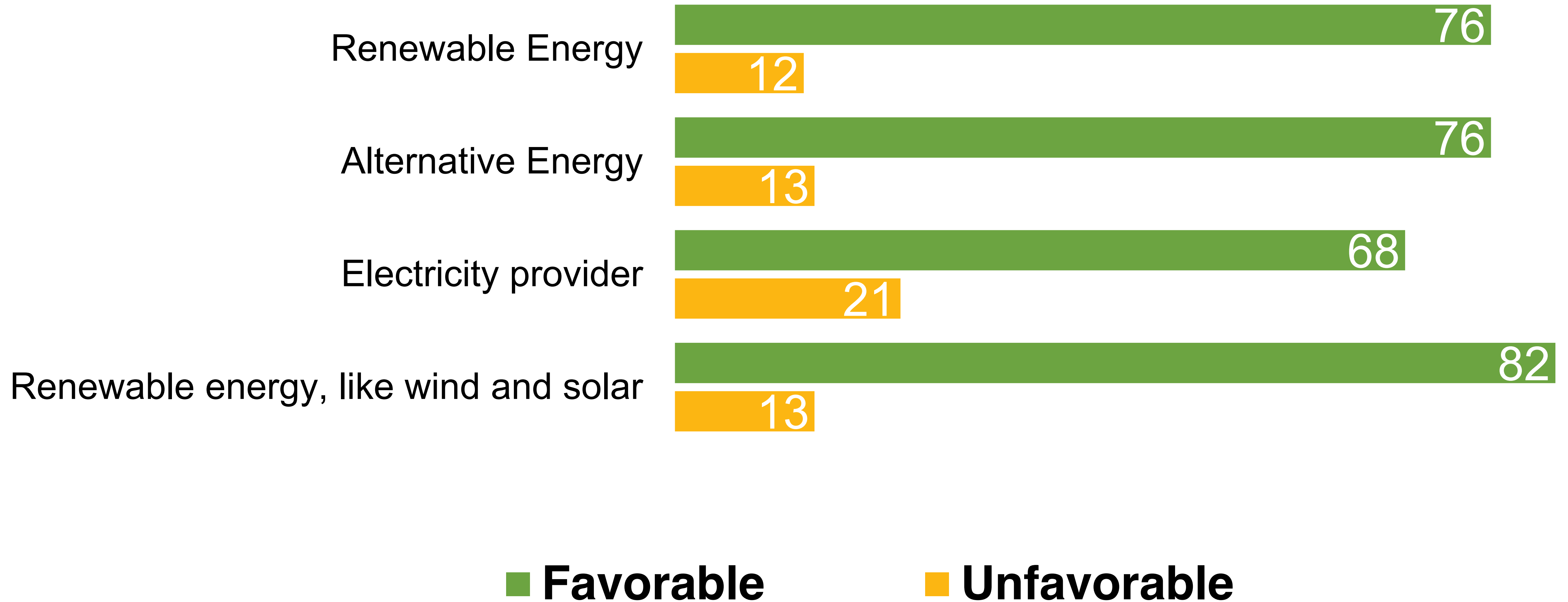

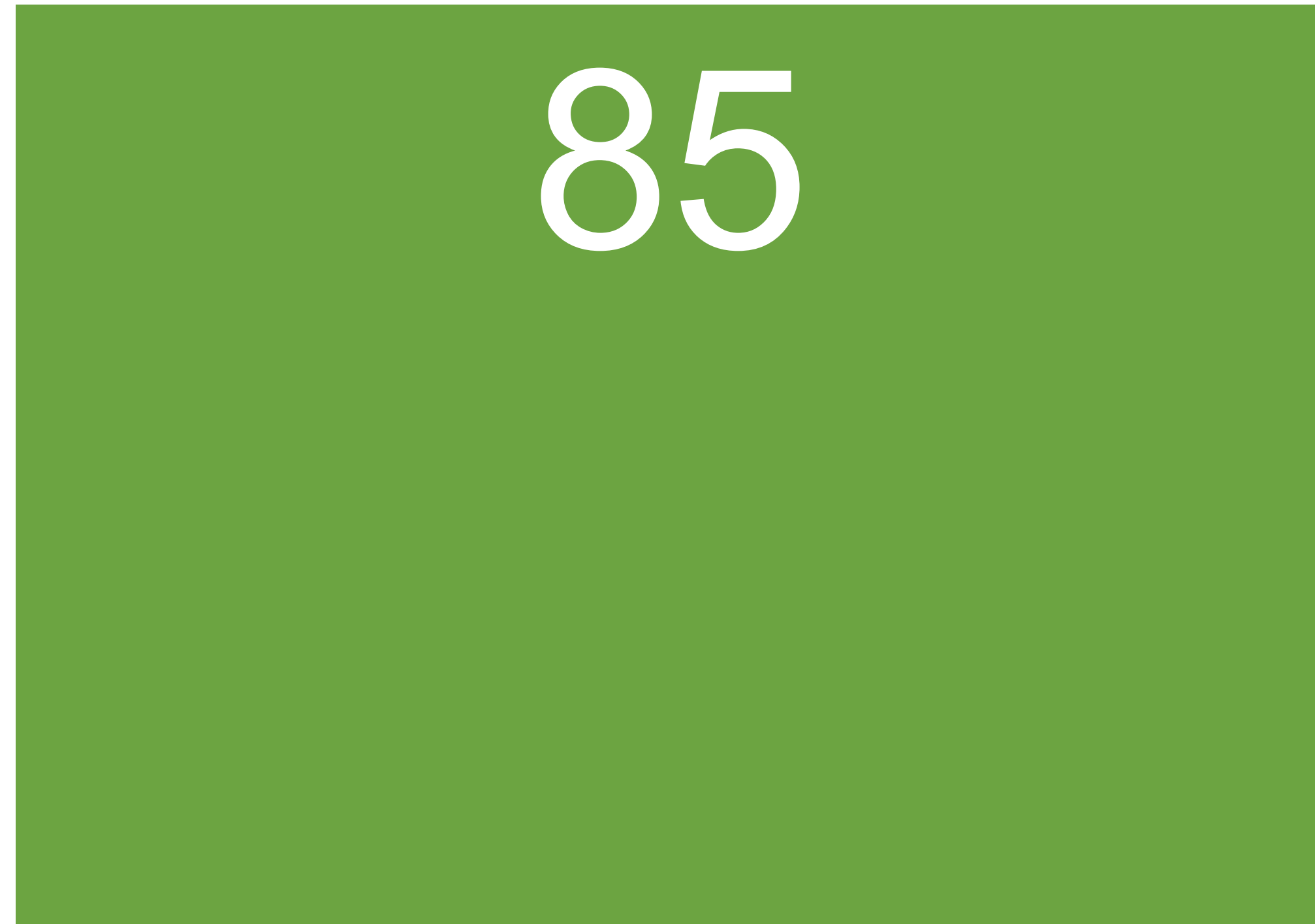

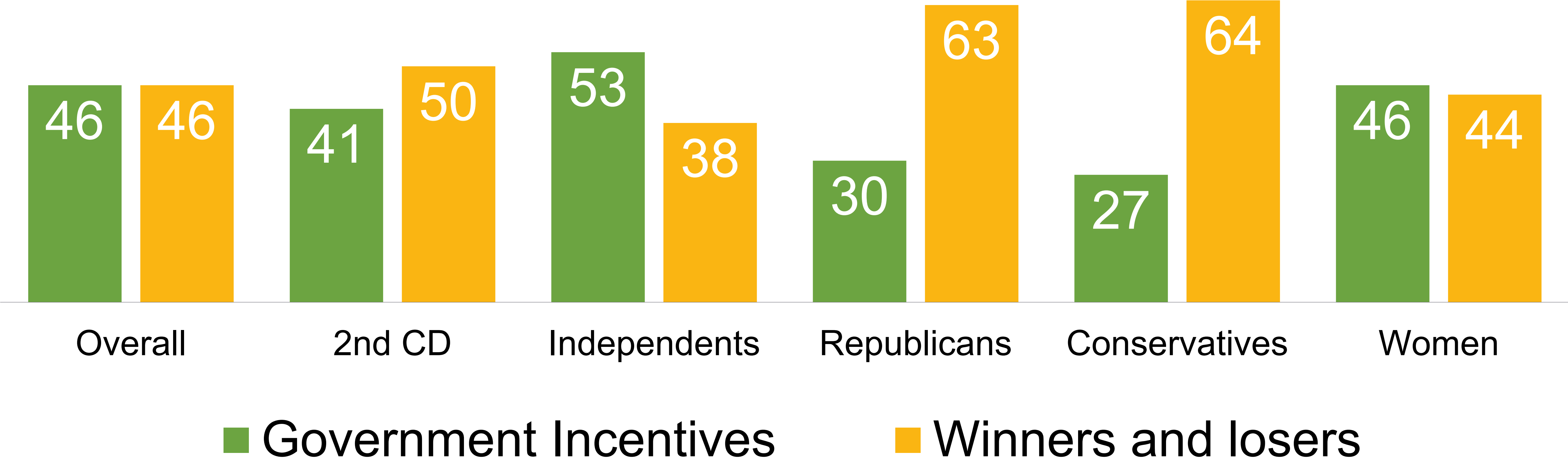
Many great technologies, like the Internet, required government incentives for their initial development. Renewable energy is the way of the future and is no different in requiring government incentives for it to scale up.
