IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, pursuant to NRS 21.270 *et. seq.*, that Defendants DANNY TARKANIAN and AMY TARKANIAN shall appear at the Cooper Castle Law Firm, located at 5275 South Durango Drive, Las Vegas, Nevada 89113, on May 16, 2013. Defendant DANNY TARKANIAN shall appear at 9:00 a.m. and Defendant AMY TARKANIAN shall appear at 1:00 p.m. for examination and discovery under oath before a notary public, or some other officer authorized by law to administer oaths, concerning property, interests and assets of the Judgment Debtor;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that at the appointed time and location, the Judgment Debtor provide all of the documents that are requested in the attached "Exhibit 1". IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that a copy of this Order shall be served forthwith upon Judgment Debtors personally or in the manner provided for by law for the service of Summons. Failure to appear at the time and place stated above may result in a bench warrant being issued for the arrest of Judgment Debtor and/or filing a finding that Judgment Debtor stands in contempt of the Order of this Court. Documents to be provided by Judgment Debtors at examination:

- 1. All documents comprising or constituting monthly statements or other periodic statements of account from all banks and other financial institutions in which Judgment Debtor has or has had any type of checking, savings, brokerage, mutual fund, money market, certificate of deposit, or other type of interest or account for all periods from May 1, 2011 through the present date.
- 2. Copies of all passbooks, check registers, ledgers or other documents reflecting the activity and account balances since May 1, 2011 in all accounts identified in response to request no. 1 above.
- Copies of all documents relating to or evidencing any security (including, 3. but not limited to, stocks, bonds, certificates of deposit, limited or general partnership interests, limited liability company memberships, etc.) in which Judgment Debtor has had any legal or beneficial interest whatsoever at any time since May 1, 2011.
- All documents reflecting monies received by Judgment Debtor from any 4. source whatsoever, including paycheck stubs and canceled checks for services rendered or goods sold, from May 1, 2011 through the present date.
- 5. All documents reflecting each parcel of real property in which any right, title, or interest of any kind or nature whatsoever is held or claimed by Judgment Debtor. The requested documents specifically include, but are not limited to, deeds, deeds of trust, mortgage applications, closing statements, coupon books, statements of account, title insurance policies, and all other information in any way reflecting involvement with, ownership of, or transactions as regards real estate or other property owned by Judgment Debtor.

- 6. All receipts or invoices for personal property purchased by Judgment Debtor with a purchase price of more than \$1,000 since May 1, 2011.
- 7. All documents, including partnership agreements and articles of incorporation, reflecting or evidencing any beneficial interest held by Judgment Debtor in a business entity at any time since May 1, 2011.
- 8. All income tax returns and any quarterly estimates of income taxed, for the last three years.
- 9. All "1099" forms reflecting income received by Judgment Debtor for the last three years.
- 10. Documents reflecting all assets (real, personal or mixed), whether owned by Judgment Debtor individually, in any partnership or corporation form, or in joint tenancy or in tenancy in common for the past three (3) years.
- 11. All life insurance policies now upon the life of Judgment Debtor or naming Judgment Debtor as beneficiary whether direct, indirect, contingent, beneficial, or otherwise therein.
- Copies of every certificate of title for every vehicle, which Judgment 12. Debtor now owns, claims any interest in, or regularly drives.
- 13. All notes, contracts, negotiable instruments, or accounts receivable whether due or not due belonging to Judgment Debtor or in which Judgment Debtor has or has had any interest whatsoever either alone or jointly with any person or persons for three (3) years preceding the date of this Order.
- Copies of any and all documents whereby you acquired or disposed of an 14. interest in any property within the last five (5) years.
- 15. All trust documents for all trusts in which Judgment Debtor holds a beneficial interest.

- 16. Judgment Debtor's driver's license.
- 17. Judgment Debtor's social security card.

<u>Definitions</u>, Rules of Construction, and Instructions:

- 1. "Document" is defined to be synonymous in meaning and equal or exceeding in scope the usage of this term in Fed. R. Civ. P. 34(a). It includes images, works and symbols that are electronically stored and which, if printed on paper, would be the text of a document. It also means all written or graphic matter of every kind or description however produced or reproduced whether in draft, in final, original or reproduction, signed or unsigned, and includes all correspondence, telegrams, notes, email, video or sound recordings of any type of communication(s), conversation(s), meeting(s), or conference(s), minutes of meetings, memoranda, interoffice communications, or data compilations of any type or kind of material similar to any of the foregoing however denominated and to whomever addressed. "Document" shall exclude exact duplicates when original are available, but shall include all copies made different from originals by virtue of any writings, notations, symbols, characters, impressions or any marks thereon.
- 2. The terms "relate to," "related to," "relating to," and relative to," include without limitation "refer to," "summarize," "reflect, " "constitute," "concern," "contain," "embody," "mention," "show," "comprise," "evidence," "discuss," "describe," or "pertaining to."
- 3. The words "and" and "or" shall be construed conjunctively or disjunctively, whichever makes a discovery request more inclusive.
- 4. The use of the singular form of any work includes the plural and vice versa.
