RE: Letter of Intent from MGM Resorts International to File an Application under NRS

704B.310

Pursuant to NAC 704B.320, MGM Resorts International ("MGM") hereby submits its letter of intent to file an application pursuant to NRS 704B.310 no later than thirty (30) calendar days following the date of this letter.

NRS 704B.080 defines "eligible customer" as a nongovernmental, commercial, end-use customer that has an average annual load of more than 1 megawatt in the Nevada Power Company d/b/a NV Energy's ("NVE") service territory. Pursuant to NRS 704B.080 MGM is an eligible customer; MGM is a commercial customer with an average annual load of 176 megawatts of electricity used to support its Las Vegas properties, more specifically described in Exhibit A attached hereto.

MGM intends to apply to receive energy from a qualified energy provider that will provide firm energy, capacity and ancillary services from one or more identifiable new electric resources. MGM intends to purchase its total electric requirements from the energy provider. MGM will provide additional information as soon as it has selected an energy provider.

MGM will submit a Network Integration Transmission Service application commensurate with its application, MGM intends to purchase energy from its energy provider at the following point(s) of delivery (the "POD"):

- **POD:** The NVE POD at the Mead 230kV or an alternate POD on the NVE system utilizing MGM's rights to deliver all energy and ancillary services to the MGM Designated Network Load within the NVE Balancing Area Authority.
- **Physical Location of POD:** NVE POD at the Mead 230kV or an applicable alternate POD on the NVE system.

Once a provider is selected, MGM and the provider will enter into a contract relating to the provision of energy. MGM will then file its application.
